Re: Response to August 8, 2008 Letter From APOC

Dear Ms. Hill:

I am writing in response to the letter I received from your office on August 8, 2008 asking for the supplemental information referenced in my initial response to the complaint filed by McHugh Pierre on July 30, 2008.

It appears that my family's ownership of stock in Quantum Fuel was inadvertently omitted from my APOC form. The stock did not generate any income in 2007, but should have been listed in my typewritten attachment to Schedule B. By this letter, please consider these entries to be appended to the attachment:

"QUANTUM FUEL – DEBORAH BONITO/SHAREHOLDER"

"QUANTUM FUEL – MARK BEGICH/SHAREHOLDER"


In addition, as I prepared my APOC Disclosure Statement a page was missing from the E*Trade statement that I used to report necessary items. My wife's ownership of stock in Xcel Energy Inc, Citadel Broadcasting, and Frontline Inc. was reported on the attachment to Schedule B, but due to the missing page, the income from these stocks was inadvertently omitted from the list of my family's dividend and interest income in section 5 of Schedule A. Also, my dividend income from, and interest in Impac Mortgage Holdings in 2007 is accurately recorded, but income that my wife separately received from Impac was inadvertently omitted from my report. By this letter, please consider the following entries to be appended to my response in section 5:

As mentioned in my initial response, these were inadvertent omissions from my original APOC report. At no time have I intentionally left any information off my public disclosure forms. Moreover, the items mentioned above were all disclosed on United States Senate Personal Financial Disclosure form.

I believe these brief amendments should provide the necessary information to complete my 2008 APOC disclosure form as my initial response addressed the falsehood and inaccuracy of 9 of the 12 original claims. I will of course be happy to provide any additionally needed information or material. Please do not hesitate to contact me if I can be of any further assistance.
